Kiwanis helps Citizens Against Domestic Violence (CADV) with \$4,900

Angie Fiene, CADV Executive Director updated Kiwanis members this week on the variety of programs that protect abused women, men and children in Camden County.

Last year CADV provided first time services to 267 women,10 men and 127 child victims of domestic and/or sexual violence, answered 446 hotlines, and provided 3,311 bednights of safe shelter.

Checks totaling \$4900 from Kiwanis & Christmas for Kids were presented to help support the day to day expenses of CADV.

CADV/VOC provides a variety FREE and CONFIDENTIAL services to victims of domestic and sexual violence. Some of these include:

- 24-hour Hotline answered by qualified trained staff or volunteers
- Crisis Intervention for individuals
- Safe shelter provides emergency housing and support services for women & children
- Hospital Advocacy with Lake Area Sexual Assault Response Team (SART)
- Court Advocacy provides information, support, assistance, accompaniment and intervention with any aspect of the civil or criminal legal system
- Crime Victims Compensation provides assistance in filing for compensation

Ozark Coast Kiwanis is one of the largest service organizations at the Lake. All funds raised go back to the Lake Community to support dozens of children focused programs that depend on Kiwanis to fund and run their programs.
