2. Our new support dog Melanie has arrived after completing extensive training. She provides our kids with unconditional love, support and friendship. Kids sit beside her, pet her and sometimes just talk to her. Her presence helps relieve their stress and fear of talking about their experiences. Melanie accompanies children in Forensic Interviews.
