YES...there are homeless at the lake...not just in the cities. Typical folks needing help are going through life transitions like divorce, death of a loved one or have lost their job or home.

Ron Estep, Executive Director of Helping Hands, shared with Kiwanis members an overview of 2014 activities serving over 400 men women and children.

Lake Area Helping Hands Homeless Shelter provides temporary and emergency shelter and transitional housing for homeless men, women, children and families in Camdenton and surrounding areas. Helping Hands provides a safe environment for residents to live in while seeking employment, saving money and receiving the counseling needed to become independent.

Helping Hands Thrift Store is located 3 miles south of Camdenton on Hwy 5. The Thrift Store proceeds help provide food and shelter to 40 individuals every night....The Thrift Store is open 9 to 4 Tues, Thurs, Fri & Saturday. New, unique and rare items are arriving daily. Household, Small Appliances Books and more...Expect to find a bargain and something you really need.

Ozark Coast Kiwanis is one of the largest service organizations at the Lake. All funds raised go back to the Lake Community to support dozens of children focused programs that depend on Kiwanis to fund and run their programs.
